SAMPLE ITINERARY

The days or timing for excursions conducted may vary for your tour but the inclusions remain the same (unless for reasons out of our control). The final itinerary for each departure is issued with documentation.

DIRECT FLIGHTS

The itinerary connects with the direct flight to/from Sydney. If opting for the direct flight, Brisbane to Norfolk Island additional nights of stay pre and post tour dates are required. Additional accommodation cost applies.

DAY 1 Arrival to Norfolk Island

Flights (from Sydney) arrive in the afternoon and a transfer is provided from the airport to our group hotel. In the afternoon, our on-island host will meet the group at the hotel for an introduction. Tonight, join your fellow travellers for a group dinner, before touring the island starts tomorrow.

FREE TIME EXTRAS:

If you have arrived prior to day one, you may like to take the opportunity to visit the nearby Cyclorama; see the island's story and cast your eye over the local shop where you arrange entry to see Cyclorama (small entry fee applies).

DAY 2 Discover Norfolk

At breakfast our local host will be on hand to answer any queries and recap the day's excursion's ahead before you set off on your morning tour with your local driver-guide.

Morning: Discover Our World Tour An introductory tour taking you on an Island wide route covering the main points of interest including commentary on the early island and peoples' history as well as the current day environment.

Afternoon: Pitcairn Settlers Village
Experience the proud history of the
Pitcairn Island Settlers. Your guided
tour will take you through the gracious
original Bailey homestead & gardens.
Then on to a stroll through the barn, dairy
and out-buildings. Wander through the
Museum filled with items of nostalgic and
historic interest. See the oldest working
forge in the Pacific. After that there's an
Ex New Zealand Army hut, with wartime memorabilia. And finally, there's an
exclusive film of Norfolk Island interest
and complimentary refreshments.

Progressive Dinner

A legendary fixture on Norfolk Island itineraries - get a taste of the real Norfolk lifestyle. Dine at three homes in three completely different parts of the island. The evening includes a Bounty mutineer descendant entertaining you with his story of life on Norfolk, and locals of the island's sharing remarkable history, the cultural heritage, practices and industries of the island. They'll share their passion for their little island paradise.

DAY 3

Colleen Mc Cullough Home. Convict History.

An easy paced morning before setting of mid morning. At breakfast our local host will be on hand to answer any queries and recap the day's excursion's ahead before you set off on your day's discoveries.

Morning: Colleen McCullough Home A glimpse into the life of this modern-day literary icon. The world-renowned author called Norfolk Island home for almost 36 years. It is here that she created some of her most powerful books, at her beloved property "Out Yenna". Colleen authored some 24 books during her lifetime. Some of the more noteworthy, for instance, include "Tim", "The Thornbirds" and "Morgan's Run".

Afternoon: Convict Kingston Tour
Learn about World Heritage Listed
Kingston. You'll hear about the first
settlers, the Polynesians who came 900
years ago. And gain an insight into our
first and second settlements as well as the
facts and legends associated with each.
After that you'll learn how Norfolk became
home to the descendants of the infamous
Bounty mutiny and there's time to walk
through the historic cemetery.

Evening: Commandants Dinner & Show This factual yet fun dinner theatre is and a great way to learn about Norfolk's history. Hear how the convicts were treated by sadists and reformers alike. Listen to a chilling recall of one of the infamous rebellions. Then marvel at how the Commandants and their families adapted to life in a Norfolk Island penal colony, recreating a little piece of England in the Pacific. Take in the show with a three course dinner created with traditional English fare to compliment the theatrical setting.

DAY 4 Breakfast Bushwalk. A Taste of Norfolk.

Morning: Breakfast Bushwalk

The walk caters for varied fitness levels with a barbeque breakfast waiting at the end; a relaxed ramble through the National Park. You'll walk along the

Bridle Track which runs from Red Road to Captain Cook's Memorial. Your local guide can help you identify local grasses, ferns, shrubs and trees as well as bird species. For those that want to sleep in, or the walk does not suit we can arrange a pick up later to join the walkers for the BBQ breakfast. Walkers depart around 7:15am

Returning from your walk, the rest of the morning is at your leisure until your afternoon tour.

Afternoon: Taste of Norfolk

Enjoy meeting some passionate locals. Visit a beekeeper's home where you will view flow hives. Here you'll learn about the fascinating local honeybees and view their incredible flight path to their hives. Next stop a local farm and the last visit will be a cooking demonstration. Here you will create green banana fritters flavoured with local honey, sit back and relax and enjoy.

Early Evening: Island Fish Feast

Set with the magnificent backdrop of the ocean stretching to the far horizon a relaxed dinner of scrumptiously fresh, local fish prepared the local way and accompanied with a range of seasonal island dishes including those passed down from Polynesian fore-mothers. The feast kicks off with entertainment, by a local singer and Tahitian-style dancers.

MORNING: Gardeners Delight Tour

Visit four amazing gardens;

- a behind the scenes look of a market garden complete with a flower garden and an orchard

TRAVEL TO NORFOLK ISLAND

- From Sydney and Brisbane you depart Australia to Norfolk Island from the international airport terminal - but, you don't go through the passport Smart E-gates as it's still considered a domestic flight. Instead, go to a manned passport control both.
- Security check with limits on liquids, aerosols and gel applies.

GST ON NORFOLK ISLAND

GST and other indirect taxes don't apply to Norfolk Island.

The Norfolk Island GST ceased on 1 July 2016 and the Australian GST doesn't apply to Norfolk Island residents. Therefore Norfolk Island businesses shouldn't charge GST, or advertise prices including GST, or issue invoices including GST for transactions on Norfolk Island. More ATO information.
